Until a few months ago, I had not bothered with the Drouin Collection on Ancestry, because I thought that it would have only French Canadian Catholic content.

However, I was very wrong with that assumption.

Not only is the Drouin Collection fully searchable, but all pages have been scanned, enabling the viewer to examine and download digital copies.

# A Case Study

Background:

Recently, I was researching a cousin from Prince Edward Island.

Charles Elisha Braddock left the Island as a single man for the United States, to fight in the Civil War. He subsequently married and had eight children born there, between the years 1866-1879.

He and his family moved to Whitton, Compton County, Québec, where they had one child, in 1879, then to nearby Ditchfield, Beauce Québec, where they had three more children, between the years 1881-1885.

# A Case Study

## Census Records:

Given the range of years for his children's birth, I first looked at census returns, beginning with the 1881 Canada Census. Charles, his wife and four of their children were found in Ditchfield.

In the 1891 Canada Census, they were still in Ditchfield, with their four youngest children.

# A Case Study

Drouin Collection:

Having selected All Categories in Ancestry, I found 'Quebec, Vital and Church Records (Drouin Collection), 1621-1967' for a Charles Henry Braddock. He is the second youngest child of Charles Sr. and Jeannie (MacCaull) Braddock.

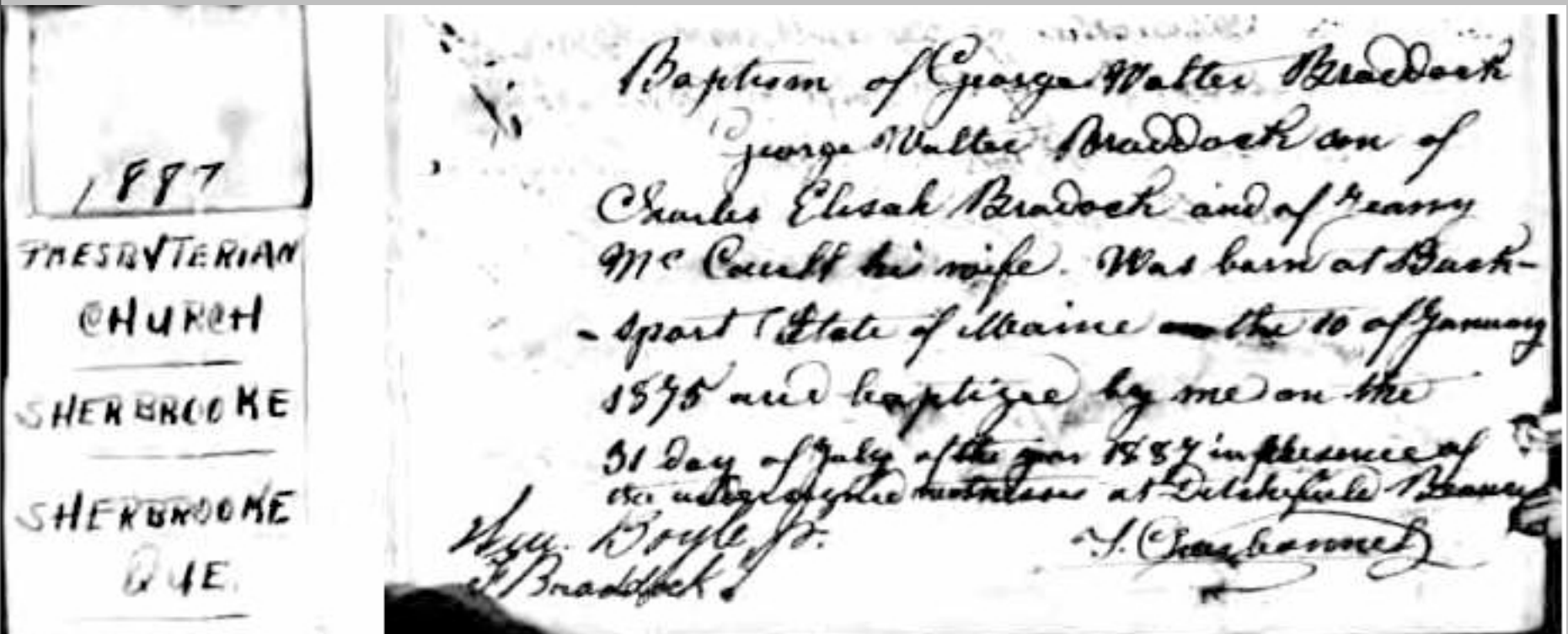

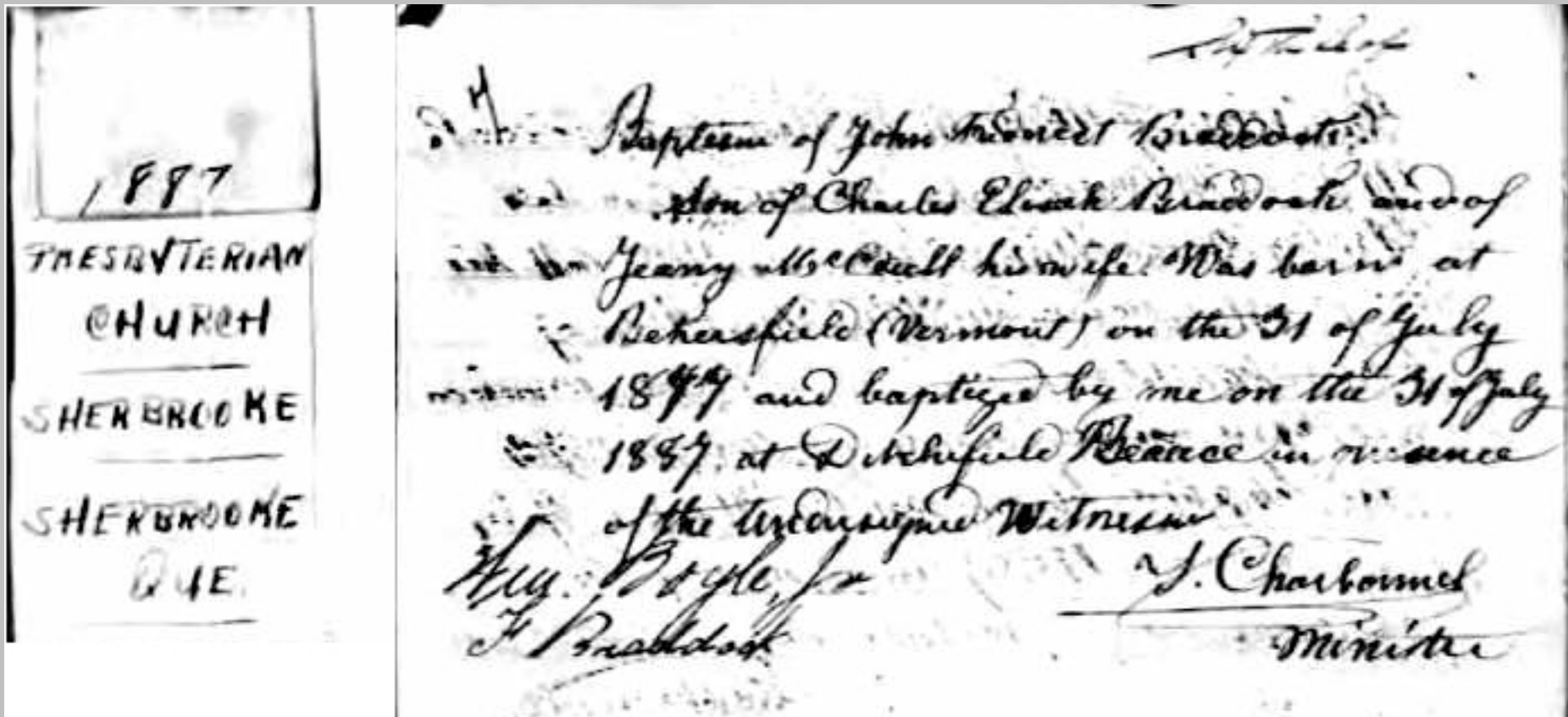


Baptism record for George Walter Braddock, Drouin Collection, Ancestry.ca.

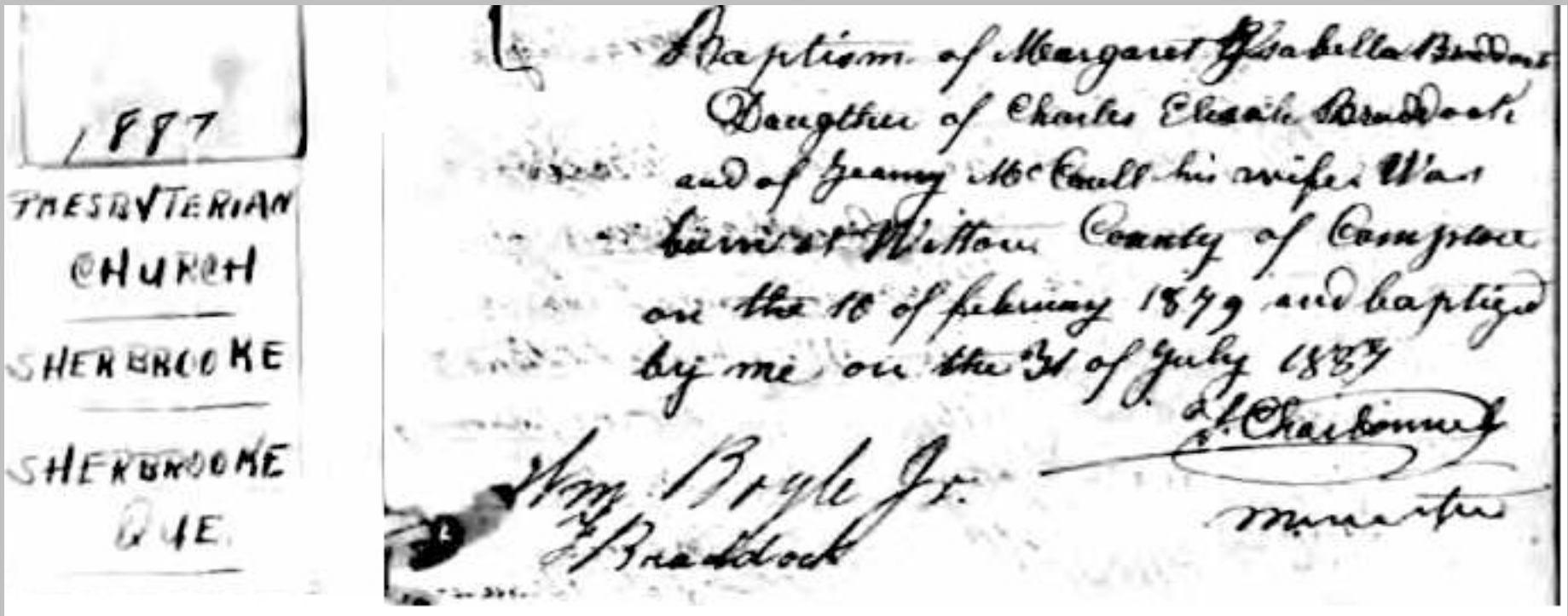
