Three documents:

Missing Exhibit

- The only way to correct this message is to find the Exhibit in the Exhibit Log and either delete it or correct the link in the Exhibit Log to where the Exhibit file is located (e.g., correct the file path.)
- You can correct the file path link by highlighting the Missing Exhibit in the Exhibit Log and clicking on the [Properties] button in the lower right of the Log window. Then click on the [Load] button in the Properties window and browse to the location of the missing Exhibit in your computer files. Then save the correction by clicking [OK] on the Properties window. Do this for all other missing Exhibit. and that will correct the problem.
- Of course, if the actual files are no longer on your computer or you no longer need the Exhibits, then just click [Delete] in the Exhibit Log for the highlighted missing Exhibit.

Primary Exhibit

How do I get the photo I want into the image window? TMG automatically puts one of my exhibits there but not the one I want.

- If you have multiple Exhibits attached to a person, only one of those is designated as the Primary Exhibit. The first attached Exhibit is always marked as Primary, but you may change that.
- *Note that these are person Exhibits - ones attached to the person. Any Exhibits attached to events, Sources, Repositories, Citations, places, or as General Exhibits may not be marked as Primary.*
- When you have the Exhibit Log window showing, with a number of exhibits, there are buttons at the lower quadrant (Add, Scan, View/Edit, Delete Primary, Properties).
- Highlight the image you want included, then press the [Primary] button. That will put that image in the Image Window.

TMG Utility

- John Cardinal: it's a good idea to check the Project name to confirm that you are editing the same project in TMGU as you are using in TMG.
- Check that you are using your TMG9 file and not your TMG8 file, particularly if you have not used TMGU since updating to TMG9.

TMG 9.05

TMG 9.05 is available. You can perform the update one of two ways:

1. From within TMG, select “Check for an update” from the Help menu.
2. Download directly

TMG Alternates Update

- Family Historian v6 released 9 Dec.
 - 11 Dec: “TMG database (11,500 people) imported into Family Historian v6.0 just fine except that none of the Memos came over in the import.”
 - 12 Dec: Several reports that FH6 crashes when you import witness information. We will be investigating this and will release a fix for it (and any other TMG import problems) as soon as possible.
