So it shows up better I edited the Marriage tag so it is in all caps MARRIAGE. I also capitalize my census tags: CEN-1900, CEN-1910, etc. If the day comes when we can color accent tags, I can easily return the labels to lower case.

I set my census tag label to "\_\_Census" (i.e. two underscores before "Census"). This has two effects.

First, my census tags now appear to be indented in my person view tag lists.

Secondly, my census tag now sorts to the top when I am adding a new tag! When you add a tag and the tag type selection window pops up, the first item in the alphabetic list is automatically highlighted. Since underscores sort to the top, this makes my census tag the "default" tag to be selected and I can select it simply by hitting a carriage return.

This would work with other tag types as well.

And, as VB pointed out, when you change a tag label, it affects all existing tags as well as any added in the future. And, if you decide later you don't like it, it is very easy to change them to something else.
