Next to a child's name in the children section of a person page entry	Children of Mary Graham and Solomon Lawrence :  Maud Hattie Lawrence + (1870 -1963)  Minnie Lawrence






- Can go before (as shown) or after the name

- Icons are controlled via a flag field and a context. Second Site uses the value of a flag to determine which icon to show for a particular person.

For the Multibirth flag, omit multibirthn.gif if you want to avoid having an icon for everyone.

	3 - Triplets (multibirth3.gif)

John C. **Hagel** was born on 1 Oct 1889 **in Russia**.¹

John C. Hagel was a railroad worker.²

The United States instituted a draft during World War I. The first registration was on June 5, 1917 for men between the ages of 21 and 31. This included men born between June 5, 1886 and June 5, 1896. John C. Hagel filled out a draft card on 5 Jun 1917 **at 1720 Hold Street, Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, USA**, . He was employed as a railroad worker at Missouri Pacific Railroad.. He was described as medium height and stout build, with brown eyes and dark hair.¹

Although the associated icons might say "WW1", "WW2" etc, this no way implies that the listed person undertook active service, but does indicate that they were employed in a military capacity at the time of the listed conflict. In saying this, it should be noted that , in most cases, the person did undertake active service, and, in some cases, lost their lives in the process.

For those person that might be listed with a "OTH" icon this indicates that they were engaged in "some sort" of military capacity (not necessarily active service) outside the dates of the major conflicts.
